

## Reloading Windows 7 on your Netbook

Netbooks, for the most part, do not have cdroms. So you'll need a procedure handy to quickly follow to reload the Netbook if the need should arise.

### Requirements:

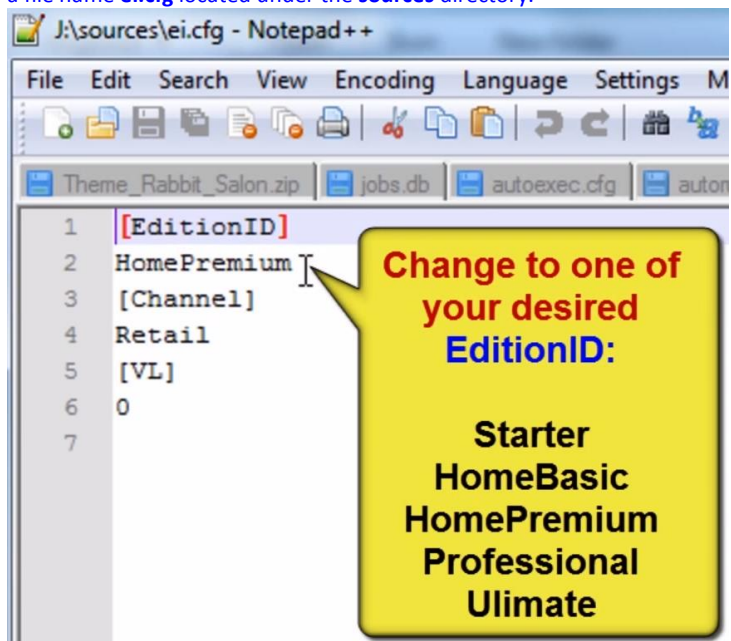
- 1>You'll need A windows Install disk
- 2>USB stick of min 8 gig

Next we need to prepare the the USB stick by copying all the setup files from the Windows Install disk to the USB Stick and then make the USB Stick bootable.

- 1> Connect your USB stick
- 2> Place your Windows install disk in the cdrom drive.
- 3> Open command prompt as Admin
- 4> enter the command **diskpart** and hit enter
- 5> enter command **list disk** and hit enter - notice which disk is the USB stick. (disk 2)
- 6> enter **select disk 2** and hit enter
- 7> enter **clean** and hit enter
- 8> enter **create partition primary** and hit enter
- 9> enter **select partition 1** and hit enter
- 10>enter **active** and hit enter
- 11>enter **format fs=ntfs quick** and hit enter
- 12>enter **assign** and hit enter
- 13>enter **exit** to exit from command prompt
- 14>notice the drive letters assigned for your windows disk and USB stick  
Windows = D: and USB Stick = E:
- 15>enter **xcopy d:\\*. \* /s/e/f E:\**
- 16>set boot order to boot from USB stick
- 17>boot from USB stick and install windows from there
- 18>delete all existing partitions and format prior to reload of windows

### NOTE!!!

After you copy all the Windows Install disk files to your USB Partition for install on your Netbook, You can then change the version to match that of the Netbook installed Version by modifying a file name **ei.cfg** located under the **sources** directory.



Or delete that file (ei.cfg) from the install disk and ALL version will be available at install time. This creates a **UNIVERSAL Windows 7** Install disk.
